All items should be labeled with student name

General Items - *should be with all students each day*

Divided organizational tool – We strongly recommend a multi-subject (at least 8) Pentaflex /accordion file or individual folders *for each subject*. We strongly advise against large Velcro binders.

Supply bag/pencil pouch to include:

- #2 pencils
- Blue, black, and red pens
- Highlighters (multi-colors – at least 3)
